

Morning Book Discussion Program

On June 29, library's morning book discussion program will focus on Toni Morrison's "The Bluest Eye." Published in 1970 it's Morrison's first book of note. The story addresses the issue of obsession with beauty and conformity through the main character, a young black girl, Pecola Breedlove. The discussion will begin at 10 a.m.

The group usually meets the first Monday each month. The meetings last an hour and a half to two hours. Participants take turns bringing a light refreshment. No attendance requirement - attend discussions that are of interest. The library purchases a copy of each selection that may be checked out by library patrons when the book is not reserved for the discussion. Copies of the books are made possible through inter-library loan and are available at the library.


One daily pass per day (co-pay) NOTE: A pass admits a family (up to four people) into the museum at 50% off the cost of regular museum admission.






